Dear DMEPOS Providers:

In an effort to provide further response and clarification to ongoing questions and concerns regarding the recent changes to the DME and O&P policy manuals, the Department, in collaboration with its Medical Management agent, Georgia Medical Care Foundation (GMCF) will host two (2) web-based educational sessions. The objectives of the educational sessions are to communicate the intent of the policy changes, respond to provider's questions and concerns, and to solicit provider input/feedback.

WebEx is an industry leader in providing online meeting and training applications. The web-based educational sessions are accessible to providers throughout the state without leaving the workplace. The WebEx sessions are facilitated via computer and telephone call in number.

Online registration is required. The WebEx is limited to **50 registrations per session**. The information is repeated in both sessions; therefore, providers are respectfully asked to register for only one session in order to accommodate as many providers as possible. A recorded version of the 'live' educational session will be posted on the GMCF web site following the live sessions.
